To amend the Act of October 19, 1965, to provide additional authorization for the Library of Congress James Madison Memorial Building.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, That section 3 of the joint resolution entitled "Joint resolution to authorize the Architect of the Capitol to construct the third Library of Congress building in square numbered 732 in the District of Columbia to be named the James Madison Memorial Building and to contain a Madison Memorial Hall, and for other purposes", approved October 19, 1965 (79 Stat. 986; Public Law 89-260), is amended by striking out "\$123,000,000" and inserting in lieu thereof "\$130,675,000".
